

Application deadline: April 1, 2022 for consideration for a 2023 exhibition

The Art Base exhibition program focuses on opportunities for solo, group, and guest-curated exhibitions for Colorado-based artists, with an emphasis on those living in the Roaring Fork Valley. Artists selected by our Exhibitions Committee can be at any stage of their careers. We strive to achieve diversity in topics and media, and we give preference to proposals of recent or new work that has not been previously exhibited in the Valley.

Selection Process: Artists are selected by the Exhibitions Committee of the Art Base. The committee reviews all applications submitted to the program. Selection is based on the merit of the artist's portfolio and the proposal.

- 1. Your website with up to 10 images of your work and other relevant weblinks, or email up to 10 low resolution images that are most representative of your work. For each image, include:
 - Title
 - Medium
 - Year completed
 - Size in inches
 - Price
- 2. Artist Statement
- 3. CV or exhibition resume
- 4. Exhibition proposal: what is the theme of your exhibition/describe the body of work you intend to show.
- 5. List dates and venues of other locations you have shown in the Roaring Fork Valley within the last year and where you plan to show currently or in the upcoming year.

Artist Expectations:

- 1. Please consider becoming a member of the Art Base.
- 2. The Art Base plays a major role in the economic and cultural vitality of historic Basalt. It is expected that you participate in a public art talk or presentation to promote the exhibition. In addition, we expect you to offer an art demonstration, class or gallery walk-through in coordination with our education program.
