Job Description: The Art Base is seeking part-time interns. Duties include assisting teachers, facilitating programs, executing events, working with volunteers, and other day-to-day operations as needed. The interns will have support from experienced art educators.

Qualifications: Successful candidates will have a passion for the arts and enjoy working with students of all ages.

Dates: One to three weeks, depending on successful candidate's schedule. Some weekend and evening work is required.

Compensation: Unpaid. Interns may receive discounts or scholarships applicable to the Art Base classes. Upon successful completion of the program interns will receive a certificate of completion and the Art Base will serve as a reference for college applications or future employment.
