The Art Base is pleased to present its first group exhibition in the North Gallery at 174 Midland Ave in historic Basalt. This exhibition features Roaring Fork Valley artists who are part of the Art Base 'Circle' – meaning artists who have exhibited with us during the last 25 years. This exhibition will be on view through August 31, 2021. There will be a community opening on Thursday, June 3rd from 5-7pm.

The Art Base Circle exhibition celebrates the diversity of artwork and artists that have previously exhibited with the organization. This curated exhibition features artwork in all media, including: painting, photography, porcelain, watercolor, pastel, collage and more. Almost 20 artists will be presented including Art Base founder Deb Jones, Isa Catto, Dick Carter, Ingrid Magidson, Andrea Wallace, Allison Stewart, and many more.

Lissa Ballinger, the curator at the Art Base remarks: "This is the first group exhibition in our new space, and it seemed fitting to reflect on our history in selecting artists as we embark on this exciting new chapter for the Art Base. We look forward to welcoming visitors and locals to view artwork from our talented Valley artists."

The Art Base is a nonprofit community arts center located in Basalt, Colorado. Through education, exhibitions, and events they foster creative expression in the visual arts for all ages and abilities. Education programs are designed to be accessible to everyone and encourage creative expression and lifelong learning through arts workshops and outreach programs in partnership with local nonprofits and Basalt schools. Exhibitions focus on opportunities for solo, group, and guest-curated exhibitions for Colorado-based artists, with an emphasis on those living in the Roaring Fork Valley.
